# POLICIES

### Working with Aboriginal people

A key focus area for Fire & Rescue NSW is the establishment of strong community relationships, by building trust and rapport, through mutual respect and a shared focus on community safety.

Our <u>*Reconciliation action plan*</u> provides a framework which details the practical actions we will take to strengthen our relationships with Aboriginal people across NSW, and to improve our service delivery to Aboriginal communities.

To put our Plan to action, the following documents have been developed to provide guidance and assistance to staff.

These documents can be accessed on <u>Aboriginal Resources site</u> on Station Portal.

#### Statement of commitment to reconciliation

The <u>Statement of commitment to reconciliation</u> rescinds the previous Statement signed by the Commissioner on 30 January 2008.

The revised statement serves as a reminder of our direction and commitment as we continue to work towards meeting the needs of the Aboriginal community.

**Note:** Copies of the revised *Statement of commitment to reconciliation* will be sent to all stations and sections shortly. The statement must be displayed in all FRNSW workplaces.

#### Working with Aboriginal people protocol

The <u>Working with Aboriginal people protocol</u> has been developed to provide information and guidance in relation to contacting, consulting and communicating with, and engaging members of the Aboriginal community.

#### Welcome to and acknowledgement of country guidelines

The <u>Welcome to and acknowledgment of country guidelines</u> have been developed to assist staff with the appropriate acknowledgement of Aboriginal people as the original owners of the land.

The Guidelines are to be used at official FRNSW events.

# GENERAL

# ANZAC Day – 25 April 2012

#### ANZAC Day March

The aim of the ANZAC Day March is to give the participating veterans and the public an opportunity to honour those who served in the defence of Australia or its interests, especially remembering those who paid the supreme sacrifice or otherwise suffered as a result of their service.

FRNSW has conducted ANZAC Day Remembrance Ceremony at No 1 Station, City of Sydney, and has marched as a Unit under Command in the Sydney ANZAC March since 1928.

#### **Eligibility to march**

Eligibility to march in the ANZAC Day March is determined by the Returned and Services League of Australia. In short, anyone eligible to be a member of the RSL is eligible to participate in the March. One descendant of a deceased veteran may also honour their relative's service by wearing the relative's medals on their right breast.

#### Leave to march with the FRNSW Contingent

The Commissioner has approved special leave for all ex-services personnel who are rostered for duty on ANZAC Day and who march with the FRNSW Contingent in the *Sydney* ANZAC Day March.

This leave will not be deducted from personal credits. It is approved on the following basis:

- Personnel rostered on day shift A Platoon 10 hours leave approved from 0800 hours to 1800 hours, Wednesday 25 April 2012.
- Personnel rostered on night shift B Platoon 14 hours leave approved from 1800 hours, Wednesday 25 April 2012, to 0800 hours, Thursday 26 April 2012.

To assist Duty Commanders in maintaining Station staffing, eligible personnel who are rostered for duty as above and who desire to march with the FRNSW Contingent must submit an <u>ANZAC Day leave form</u> (available on Station Portal), through the chain of command, to the Manager Operational Staff by Friday 20 April 2012.

Attending on duty personnel *must* also complete an *ANZAC Day attendance form* which will be issued by the ANZAC Day March Coordinator, Superintendent Peter Stathis, prior to the commencement of the FRNSW ANZAC Day Remembrance Service at No 1 Station.

The obligation to obtain and return a completed *ANZAC Day attendance form* to the ANZAC Day March Coordinator rests with the individual. On duty personnel who fail to complete an ANZAC Day Attendance Form and who do not march with the FRNSW Contingent in the *Sydney* ANZAC Day March will not be granted special leave.

#### Dress

Dress uniform (full ceremonial) for uniformed personnel.

Lounge suit/smart casual for administrative and trades personnel.

#### Protocol for wearing medals

Current and former employees of FRNSW who have been awarded FRNSW Commendations and Awards who wish to honour a relative's war service by wearing their relative's medals should wear the relative's medals on the right breast *below* their FRNSW Commendations and Awards.

#### FRNSW ANZAC Day Remembrance Service

Off duty personnel and families are welcome to attend the FRNSW ANZAC Day Remembrance Service at City of Sydney Fire Station which commences at 0800 hours.
