The recommended practice for <u>Body bag: chemically resistant, fully encapsulated</u> (Ver 01) has been published on the Recommended Practices page on Station Portal.

This recommended practice describes the use of the chemically resistant, fully encapsulated body bag at incidents where the deceased presents a continuing chemical contamination hazard to emergency service workers and hospital or morgue staff.

Approval must be obtained from Hazmat management before the bags are used.
