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POLICIES

Standard Operational Guidelines policy

The <u>Standard Operational Guidelines policy</u> has been published on the Intranet.

Key points

The purpose of this policy is to define the purpose of Standard Operational Guidelines (SOGs), who must follow SOGs and roles and responsibilities. Key points of the policy are:

- SOGs provide guidance on the safe and effective management of FRNSW operations at incidents.
- SOGs suggest a safe system of work for operations at incidents and form the basis of the incident action plan.
- All staff must implement SOGs as far as practicable, or modify operations to the situation at hand with safety being paramount.
- Incident Commanders must ensure that SOGs are followed at incidents, as far as
 practicable, taking into account that certain risks and opportunities may require the
 approach to be modified.
- Administrative and technical staff, consultants and contractors must maintain an awareness of SOGs relevant to their area of responsibility and follow relevant SOGs if they respond to incidents.
- Because it is not possible to predict all situations that may occur at an incident, SOGs give firefighters the ability to use their initiative to manage an incident on the basis of risks, opportunities, training and experience within a safety framework.
- Anyone who operates outside the SOG framework, or in contravention of direct instructions contained in the SOGs, must be prepared to justify their actions if called upon to do so.
- Commanders and supervisors must ensure that all staff under their supervision read and understand SOGs as soon as possible after publication.

Intellectual Property policy

The <u>Intellectual Property policy</u> has been published on the Intranet. The policy explains how Fire & Rescue NSW's intellectual property is managed.

Key points

- Intellectual property (IP) is a creative idea or product that a person has developed.
- IP is a significant asset. IP assets created by staff are owned by Fire & Rescue NSW and the State of NSW, and as such must be managed responsibly. The Intellectual Property Policy explains the way that FRNSW's IP is managed.
- The policy is supported by an <u>IP Quick Reference Guide</u> which provides more detailed information about IP and the way IP can be protected, such as by patent, copyright etc.

Who needs to read this policy?

All staff of FRNSW should be aware of this policy and their obligations with regard to FRNSW's intellectual property.
